RESOLUTION OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY OF HART COUNTY, KENTUCKY TO
FORMALLY CENSURE SENATOR ADDISON MITCHELL McCONNELL Jr.

WHEREAS, on January 19th, 2021, Kentucky’s Senior Senator Addison Mitchell McConnell Jr. as the former Senate Majority Leader besmirched the integrity of the sitting Republican President; the Honorable Donald John Trump, by implying that the President and his administration lied about the 2020 election fraud.

RESOLUTION #1, AMENDMENT #1
